The NFPA 1584 Rehab Standard requires SOGs, ongoing education, company officer participation with EMS, equipment and supplies, medical monitoring, BLS transport available on scene, IMS integration, and specific documentation. Learn the 9 key components of 1584 compliant rehab and your options for realistic integration of rehab into your department. No longer can Rehab be an elephant on the fireground. Departments need consistent, workable, and functional systems to provide ongoing education to all members on when and how to rehab.
