

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR REVIEW OF WAYNE COUNTY  
CONSOLIDATED AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT NO. 3 ENCOMPASSING  
PORTIONS OF THE TOWNS OF ARCADIA, LYONS AND SODUS**

**A Public Hearing will be held on Wednesday, August 22, 2007 at 7 PM at Cornell Cooperative Extension, 1851 Route 88N, Newark, New York 14513**, regarding the Eight Year Review of **Consolidated Agricultural District No. 3**. The purpose of this hearing is to consider any proposed modifications of the District and recommendations of the Wayne County Agriculture and Farmland Protection Board and the Wayne County Planning Board, per Article 25 AA of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York.

At their June 26, 2007 meeting, the Wayne County Agriculture and Farmland Protection Board recommended to the Wayne County Board of Supervisors that the original Agricultural District Number 7 be modified and consolidated with portions of original Agricultural Districts 4, 7 & 8 within the Towns of Arcadia, Lyons and Sodus into Consolidated Agricultural District Number Three (CAD 3) as detailed in the Agriculture and Land Use Report for the District.

At their June 27, 2007 meeting, the Wayne County Planning Board concurred with the recommendation of the Wayne County Agriculture and Farmland Protection Board for the formation of Consolidated Agricultural District Number Three (CAD 3).

All interested parties and citizens will be heard by representatives of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors at the public hearing. Please make every effort to attend the August 22, 2007 hearing, since your comments will be an important factor in the Board of Supervisor's decision to continue, modify or terminate Consolidated Agricultural District No. 3.
